Monthly Recap

The annual Close-Up Contest took place on May 1st. The audience consisted of approximately 75 guests (one of the largest crowds the Ring has ever had for a Close-Up Contest). Steve Queen won the contest last year. Therefore, he was in charge of organizing the contest this year. At the last minute, Steve became ill so Terry Richison filled in for him. There were two categories-- Beginner/Intermediate and Advanced. There were three contestants in the Beginner/Intermediate Category. Schaper did several effects which involved predictions. D. Jay Lenz was He did an effect in which he gave two volunteers \$1 bills. Amazingly, these switched places. He also performed the "Professor's Nightmare" using three ropes of different lengths. Then Gary Chan played a "swindling" game with a volunteer (Gary always won). Advanced Category had four contestants. John Davit did several card effects and, also, a rope trick. Steve Finkelstein performed an effect using two volunteers who were a couple. He played music, used wine glasses to perform several effects, and then turned a dollar into a hundred-dollar bill. Johnny Harper also used two volunteers and performed the Torn and Restored Card effect using cards and also used thread to perform the Gypsy Thread effect. Last Dan Todd performed an effect using a six-year old boy. Dan had spoons taped to his eyes. The boy helped him perform his effect using chess pieces. The audience thoroughly enjoyed watching the contestants compete. The following volunteers judged the acts—Steve Bender, Alan Zibits, Steve Zuehlke, Christian Misner, and Barb Langston. The winners will be announced at the President's Banquet which is held in the fall.

The Ring has hosted three lectures this past month. On April 10th Scott Alexander gave a lecture. Then on April 23rd the Ring hosted a lecture featuring Bernardo Sedlacek. On May 8th the Ring hosted a lecture by Henry Evans. Scott is a well-known magician who has performed on America's Got Talent, Penn and Teller's "Fool Us", Oprah Show, etc. He is a magician who performs close-up magic, stand up comedy and also large stage shows. Scott shared his close-up magic with the Ring using comedy. Bernardo Sedlacek is considered one of the best magicians from Reno, Brazil. He has traveled all over the world sharing his talent. His lecture consisted of three parts—mini show, explanations of the mini show in full details, and A la Carte (informal talk about Henry Evans, a well-known magician from Argentina, has magic). earned several magic awards and has appeared all over the world. He also has many products for sale on the internet. The members enjoyed all three lectures. These magicians are all different so the members learned new magic effects, methods, presentations, theory, etc.

Dan Harlan to Perform at President's Banquet

Dan Harlan will be performing at this year's President's Banquet on October 18, 2019. Save the date!

Born on October 14, 1964 in Fremont, Ohio, Dan Harlan began studying magic when he was nine years old. His early influences were books by Milbourne Christopher, Bill Severn, and Martin Gardner. By the time he was 13, Harlan was performing stand-up for private parties and close-up at his weekly restaurant gig. Perhaps best known for his pioneering work with rubber band magic, Harlan is also famous for his many other unique creations which span all genres of magic.



He has appeared on and consulted for numerous TV shows in the USA and abroad. Performing, writing, teaching, consulting, creating and lecturing, Dan Harlan does it all.

Harlan's marketed creations include: Color Mixer (1987), Hold It, Buster! (1988), Starcle, Card-Toon (1992), Missing Think (1994) later released as Ghost Deck by Milton Bradley in the MagicWorks line, Card-Toon 2 (1994), Birthday Suit, Doggone Impawsible, Financial Attraction, Hot Crossed Ones, Fart-Toon (1998), Hover Card (1998), Mixed Emotions (1999), Shrinky-Ink (2000), Crazy-8 (2001), My Word! (2001), Mind Surf, Pip Art, Red Rover, Royal Oil, Captain Dread (2003), Crazy-Cash (2003), Diabolical Disc (2008), The Awakening (awarded Magic Nook's Best Rope Effect of 2010).

Harlan has appeared on many instructional videos including: Bandshark, Close-Up Magic of Dan Harlan, Magic With Rubberbands (3 Volumes), Pack Small, Play Big (4 Volumes), Ultimate Impromptu (3 Volumes), Emerson & West Packet Tricks (6 Volumes), Mindbogglers (4 Volumes), Premium Blend (6 Volumes), Harlan: Live!, and at least 12 Volumes of World's Greatest Magic. Harlan also co-published The MINOTAUR quarterly magic magazine (with Marv Leventhal).
